HOW TO REACH US

From Fiumicino Airport to Rome:

- Leonardo Express to Termini train station (30 min)
- Taxi

From Ciampino Airport to Rome:

- Bus services (Terravision or SIT shuttles)
- Taxi
- Public transport to Ciampino train station, then a train to Termini station (40 min)

From Termini Station to the Department:

- Underground Line Metro B (Blue Line) towards Laurentina. Get off at Marconi station (from there, the Department is within walking distance)
- Bus Line 170 or 766 towards Laurentina. Get off at Marconi/Lungotevere Marconi stop (schedules may vary)
- Tram Line 8 towards Laurentina. Get off at Marconi stop (check tram schedules)

SIGHTSEEING NEAR THE DEPARTMENT

The underground blue line (Metro B) connects the Department to some of Rome's major attractions.



Known for its legendary history, not only is the **Colosseum** a valuable archaeological site, but by night it lights up as do the lively clubs and bars surrounding it.

The **Garbatella** neighbourhood is a hidden gem in Rome's urban landscape. With its quaint squares and vibrant street art, it is home to the Palladium Theatre, a cultural hub supported by the Roma Tre Foundation.



One of Rome's best-preserved monuments, the **Piramide Cestia**, which Roma Tre University has adopted as its identifying symbol, stands next to the **Non-Catholic cemetery**, the final resting place of Keats and Shelley.
