The Master of Arts in International Studies (MAIS) is a two-year program (120 ECTS) taught in English which provides students the opportunity to study with an interdisciplinary approach and in an international environment.

It focuses on the political, economic, and legal aspects of globalization, human rights, peace and conflict resolution, development, and environmental issues.
