Understanding the Social Acceptability of Structural Reforms

Dr. Silvia Albrizio, Senior Economist, IMF

Policymakers are being urged to implement measures that foster competition, facilitate resource allocation to emerging sectors, and bolster labor supply amid aging populations. However, despite the clear need for action, securing broad social acceptability for policy changes has often been a significant obstacle, with reform eff orts waning since the global fi nancial crisis amid rising public resistance. This seminar explores the factors that shape public attitudes toward structural reforms and assesses the eff ectiveness of various strategies for increasing the social acceptability of policy changes.
