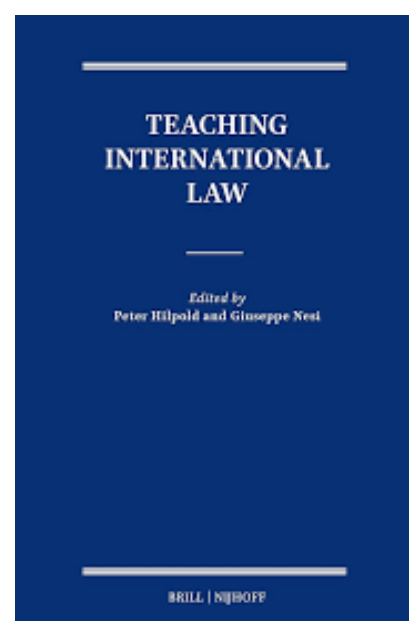
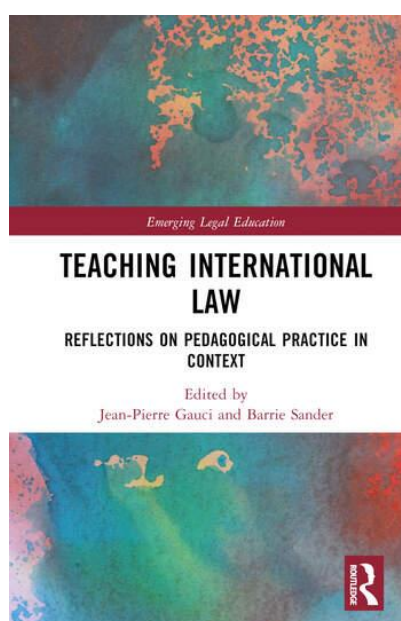
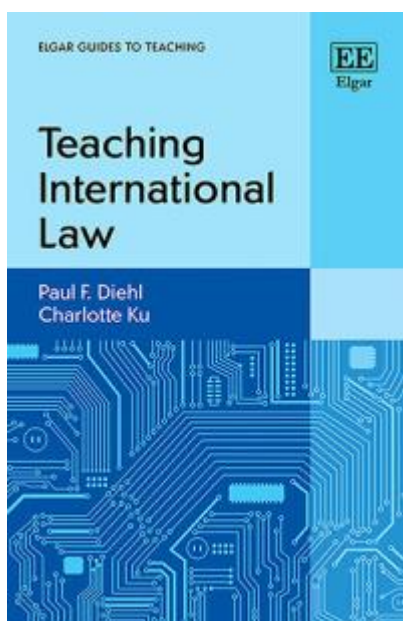




TEACHING INTERNATIONAL LAW: A DIALOGUE
