He is a partner at Justen, Pereira, Oliveira & Talamini, in São Paulo, Brazil, and is a co-head of the firm's infrastructure and arbitration practices.

He has a doctorate in public law and has been a visiting scholar at the universities of Columbia, Nottingham, and George Washington, in the areas of dispute resolution and government contracts.

He often sits as an arbitrator in international and domestic proceedings under a variety of institutional rules in English, Spanish, and Portuguese.

His practice as counsel, arbitrator and legal expert focuses mainly on infrastructure projects, government contracts, and international sale of goods, topics he has covered in books, articles, and book chapters.

Among other positions, he is currently a member of the Board of Director of the Vis East Foundation, in Hong Kong, and a co-chair of the AAA/ICDR Brazil Arbitration Advisory Committee, and President of the Court of Arbitration of the Lusaka International Arbitration Centre (Zambia).
