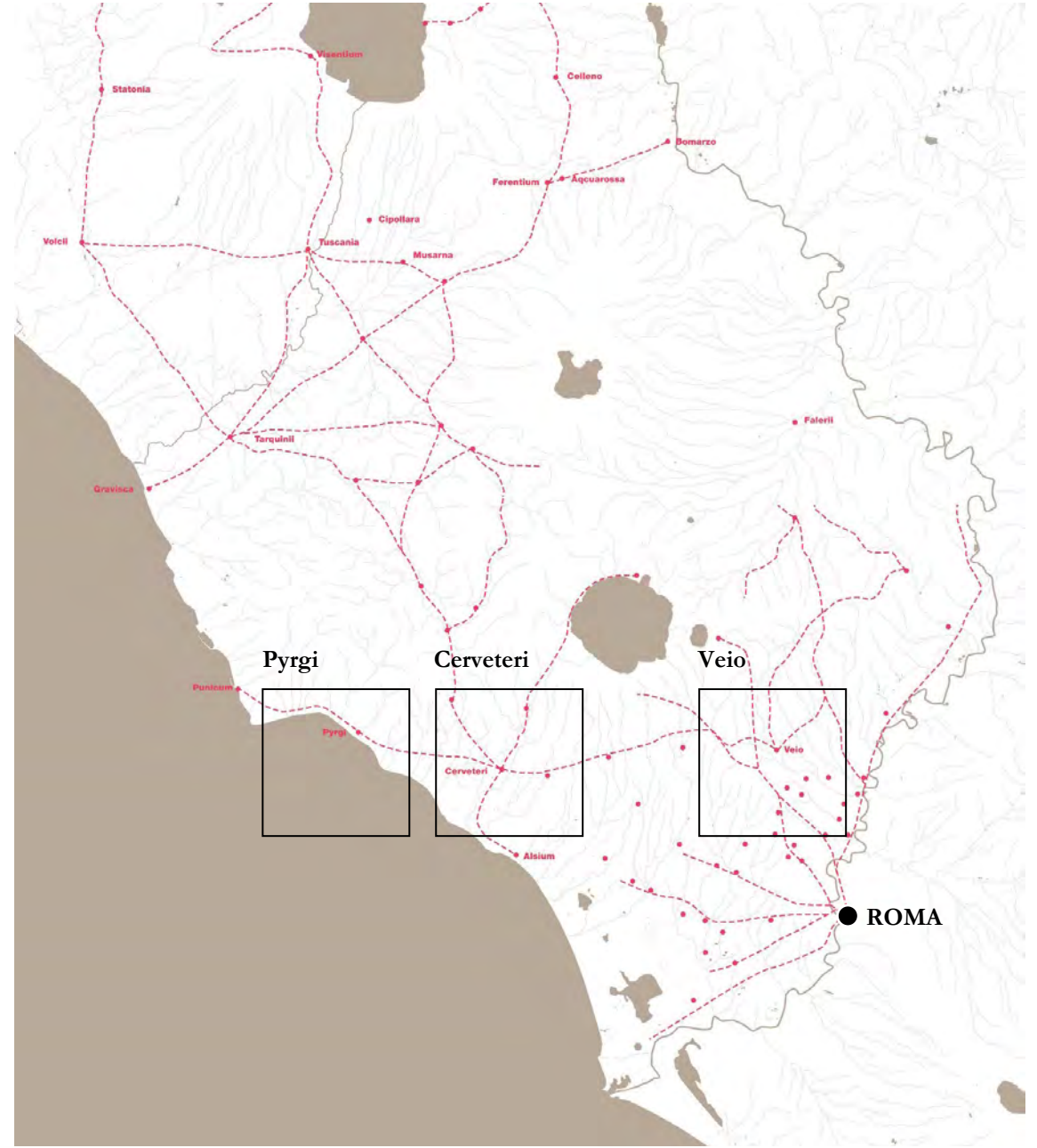
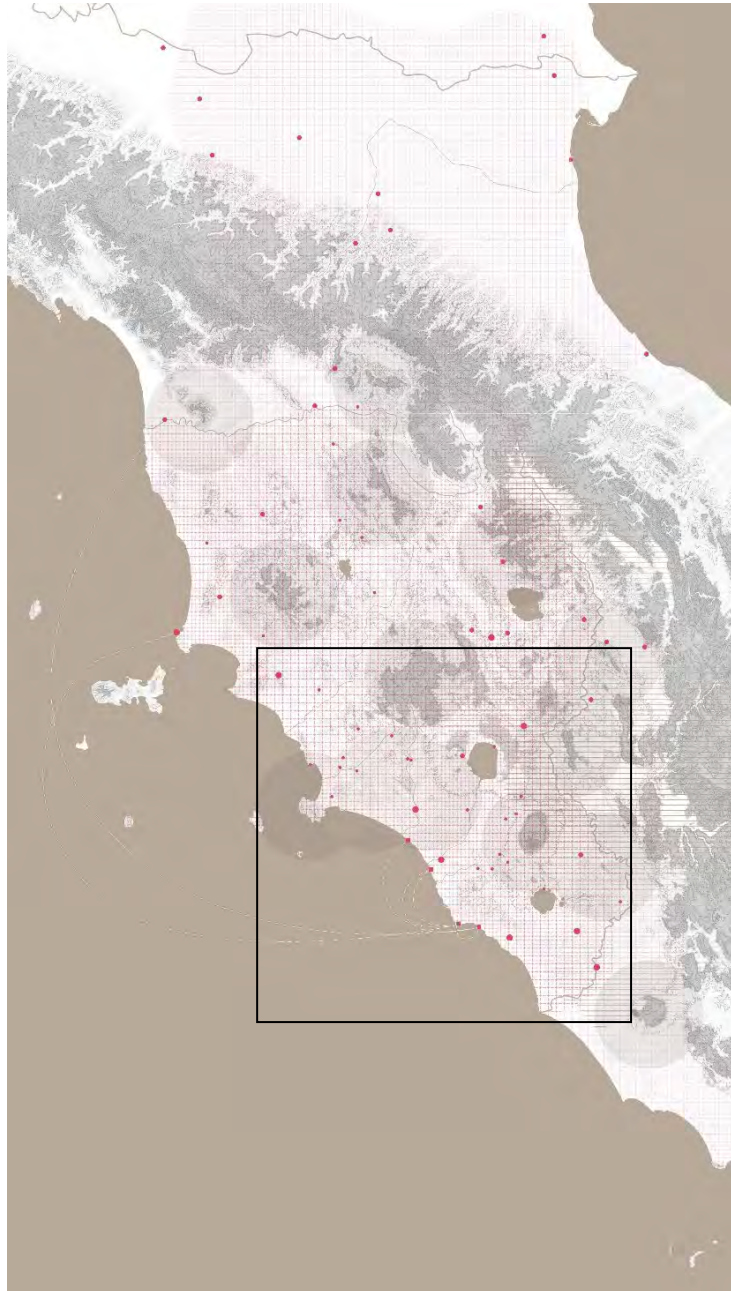
## Etruria Meridionale

On the right:

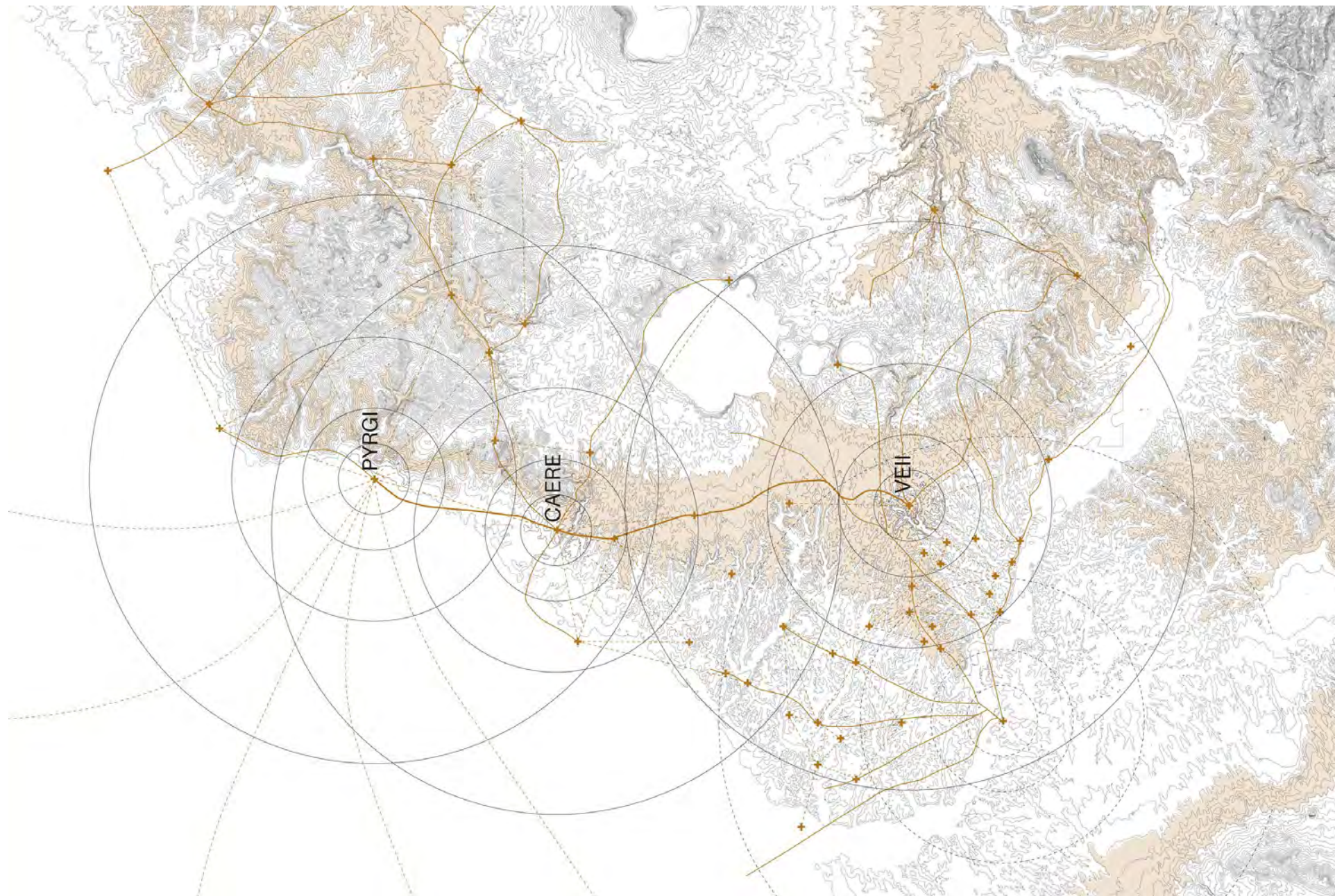
The three workshop case studies in the region of Southern Etruria and the relation with Rome

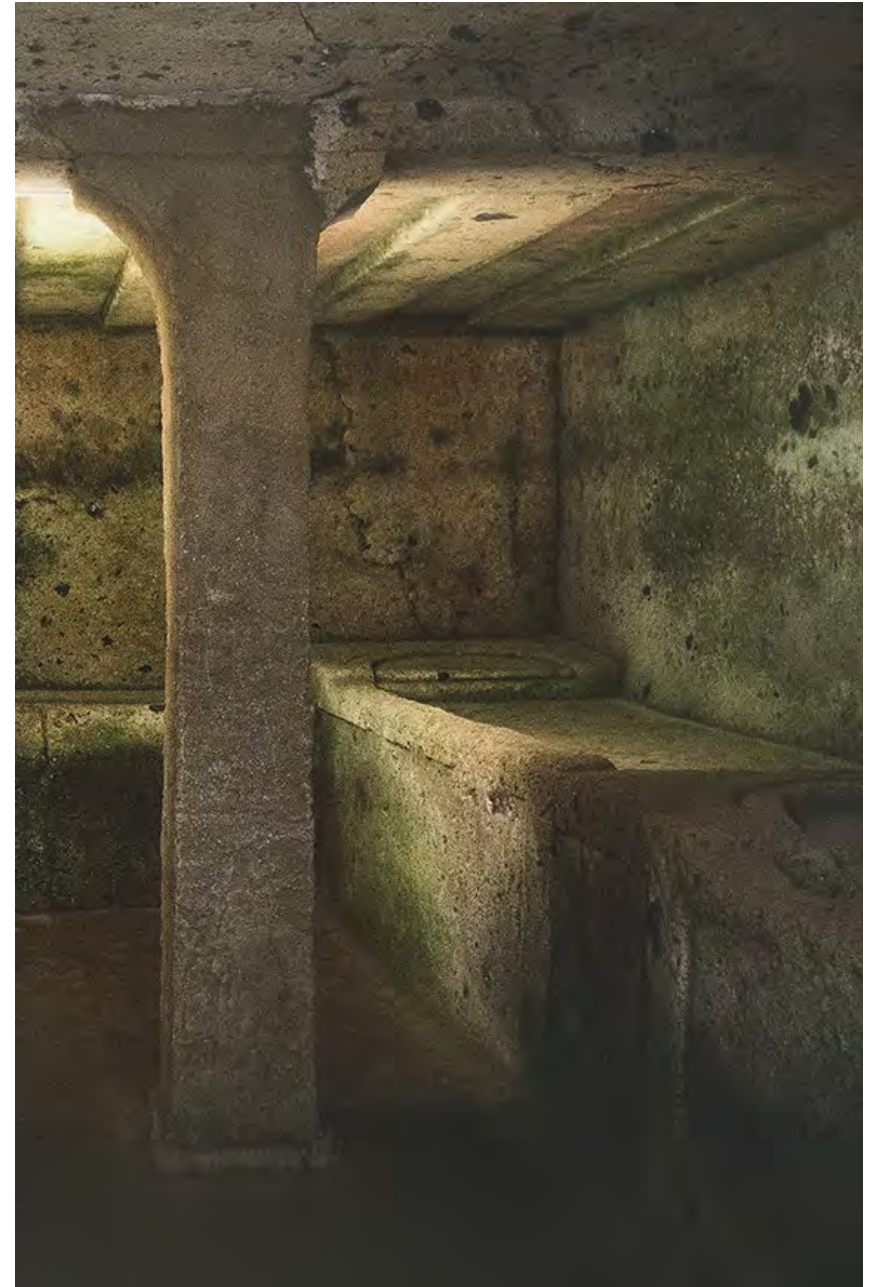

Sapienza University of Rome and Roma Tre University coordinate the international design workshop promoted by the network of DHTL - *Designing Heritage Tourism Landscapes*. The focus is the enhancement of the territories of southern Etruria, specifically, from the coast to the countryside, the archeological sites of Pyrgi, Cerveteri, Veio.

According to the past editions, the 9th DHTL workshop will run for 13 days, from 5th to 17th September 2022. The activities will be hosted in the medieval Castle of Santa Severa, (<https://www.castellodisantasevera.it/en/>). The seat has been chosen, as well as for its monumental value and spatial compatibility with the planned activities, for the strategic location close to the study areas and the easy railway connection with the city center of Rome and Fiumicino international airport.

Veio and Cerveteri - of which Pyrgi was seat of the harbor and the maritime sanctuary, one of the main sacred areas of the ancient Mediterranean - are among the most important Etrurian political and cultural centers. Thanks to their various environmental and settlement features, they validly represent two different models of "city".

The workshop time will correspond with the excavation period at Pyrgi that the Department of Ancient Civilizations traditionally leads during the month of september.

The open door activities will be accompanied by a series of thematic lectures that will mainly take place in the Castle area at night.

The topics covered and the modes of communication will be an additional opportunity to involve a wider audience.
