Nordic crossroad
Cultural centres and architectural exchanges between Italy
and the North in the early modern period

Abstract: This conference focuses on the relationship between the Nordic countries and Rome and Italy in the late Middle Ages and the early modern period. Political, religious, cultural and architectural links defined itineraries across Europe, and determined the importance of Nordic centres in a fertile and complex confrontation with the south of the continent. Scholars from Nordic Countries will introduce the cultural role of the main Nordic centres. Young Italian researchers will present their contributions to the research programme "Rome in the Nordic countries", financed by the Italian Ministry of University and Research. The programme concentrates on aspects of the Nordic countries' development of a strong and deep approach to Classicism, through pivotal aspects such as the Italian journey, the circulation of prints and illustrated books, and the development of shared cultural codes.
