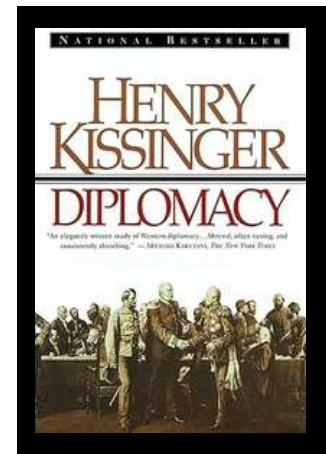

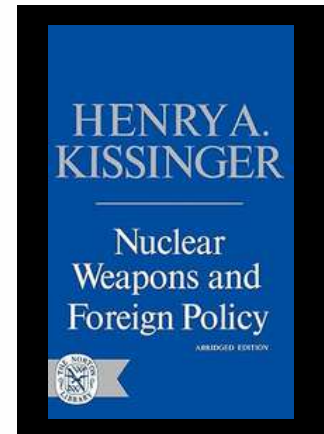

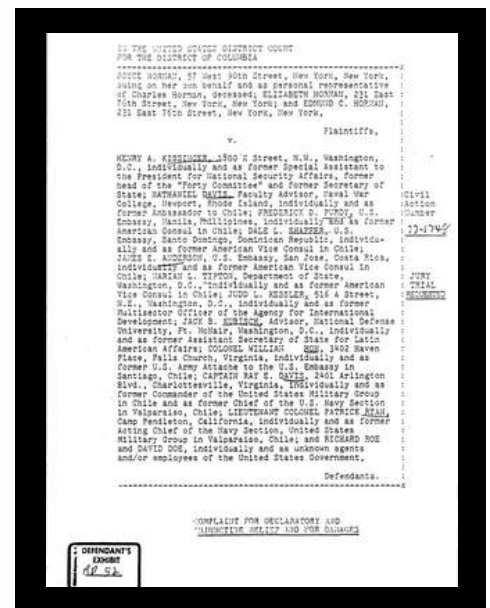
Il Digital National Security Archive è la più importante raccolta di documenti originali sulla politica estera degli Stati Uniti a partire dal 1945. Il database comprende più di 100.000 documenti desecretati relativi alle decisioni critiche assunte dagli USA nelle diverse aree del mondo ed è articolato in collezioni. La creazione dell'archivio si deve al Freedom of Information Act del 1966, che ha permesso a giornalisti e studiosi l'accesso a molti documenti di carattere storico e di attualità fino a quel momento riservati e coperti da segreto di Stato.

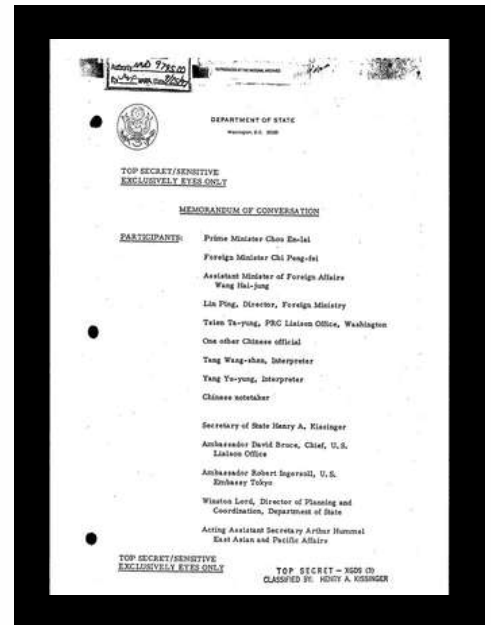

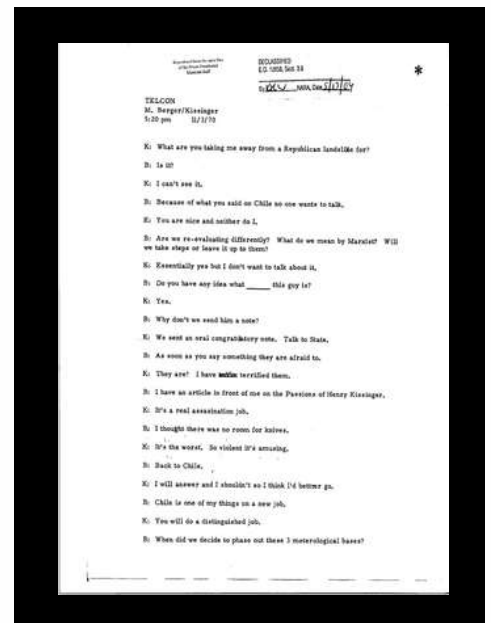

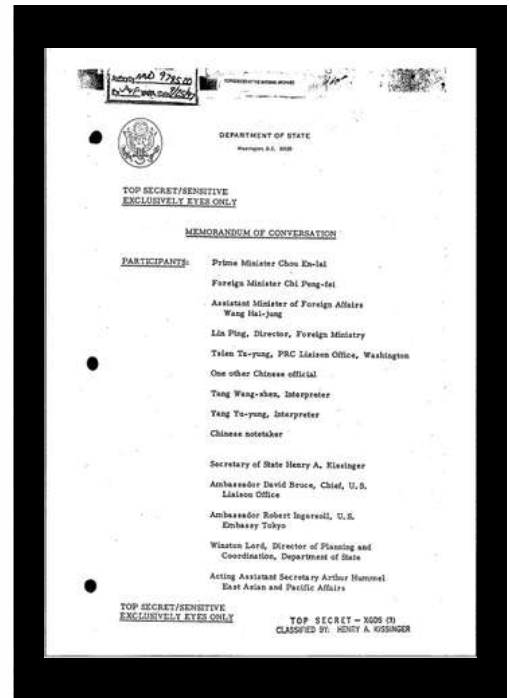

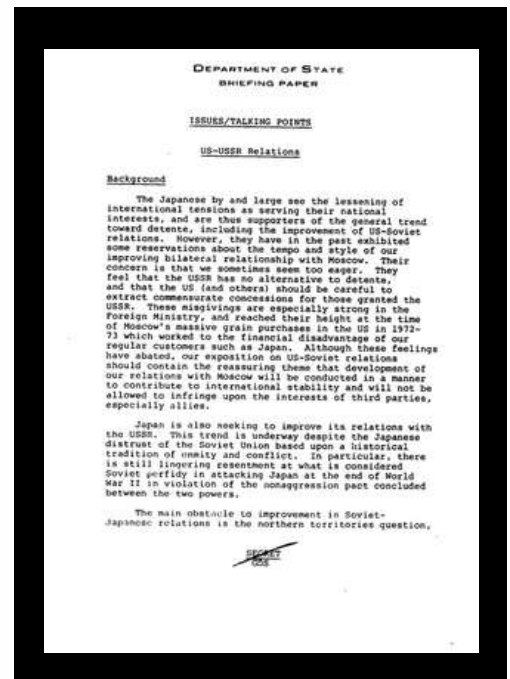

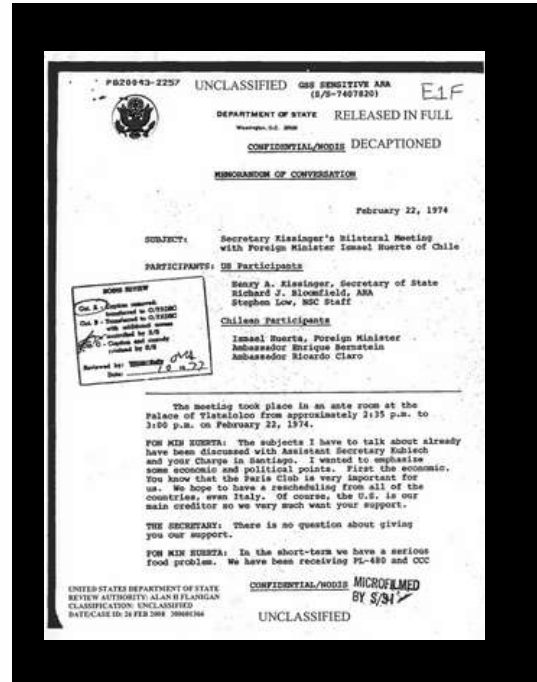

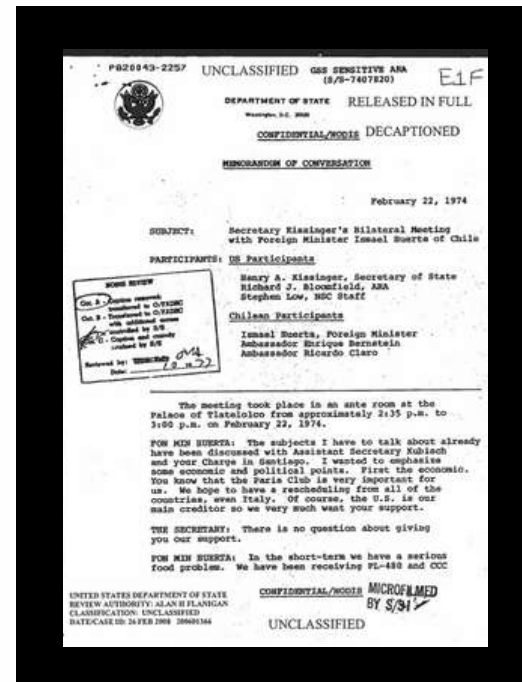
