Art.1

Pursuant to the [Regolamento di Ateneo per gli assegni di ricerca](#), a public selection process is established to award ONE grant for temporary research fellowship (“*assegno di ricerca*”) for a period of 12 (twelve) months in the Department of Architettura.

Co-creation of public spaces and natural environments in the context of transition, challenges faced by the New European Bauhaus, and the regeneration of Vigne Nuove to promote community well-being.
DESCRIPTION OF THE ANNUAL GRANT RESEARCH PROGRAMME
<p>The research grant is part of the project: “<i>We-Z- emotional Wellbeing of generation Z: reconnecting communities and spaces through imperfect health</i>”.</p> <p>In today's conjuncture of climate chaos, We-Z tests a transitional model of urban regeneration to combat increasing mental health conditions in young people. By advancing "experiences of pleasure", it develops preventive and responsive urban capacities through the valorization of diverse heritage materials and setting a Healing Community. For youth to regain its agency, the activation of new personal and collective imagination becomes the prerequisite to advance a hopeful future, sustaining the city's transition towards sustainable and stylish ways of living as encouraged by the New European Bauhaus. Breaking with medicalised responses of mental health, the project involves people with different social and mental health conditions into the cocreation of the newly named We-Z park, an urban area integrating the regeneration of Vigne Nuove complex into a larger territorial context. Vigne Nuove is a '70s public housing complex located in the North-Eastern periphery of Rome, remained largely unfinished, and today characterized by a widespread sense of neglect, isolation and unsafe. Challenging Modernist rationality through an imperfect idea of mental health, We-Z implements the former Vigne Nuove plan to test a New European Bauhaus of enjoyment. In order to re-activate affective bonds between people and places, the new realized attractors (green, public, welfare spaces and related facilities) become durable transitional devices that foster new common goods and productive ecosystems.</p>

<p>The candidate should have expertise in urban planning, with a focus on the relationship between the human body and urban spaces in contexts of urban regeneration and transition. They should have a proven track record of conducting research and studies at national and international levels, particularly in transforming urban contexts with a strong emphasis on community involvement. The candidate should also be familiar with the working methods of Living Labs in problematic and challenging neighbourhoods for regeneration actions.</p> <p>The tasks of the candidate will involve contributing to the themes of well-being and mental health in cities, demonstrating the ability to set problems, acquire materials and access sources, conduct surveys and interviews</p>

with qualified witnesses, map out the uses of the neighbourhood, even those that are hidden, participate in co-creation workshops and transformation interventions, and prepare interim and final reports. They will also be expected to collaborate in setting subsequent phases of the We-Z research program, assist in preparing and managing seminars and conferences, and engage in activities that promote and disseminate the acquired results. neighbourhood, participation in co-creation workshops and the realization of transformation interventions; drafting and preparation of interim and final reports, collaboration in setting the subsequent phases of the We-Z research program, assistance in preparing and managing seminars and conferences, and activities promoting and disseminating acquired results.

The allowances are subjected to:

- the provisions of the article 4 of Law 08/13/1984, n. 476 (fiscal treatment);
- the provisions of the article 2, paragraphs 26 and following of the law 08/08/1995, n. 335, as further amended (social security);
- the provisions of the article 1, paragraph 788, of Law 27/12/2006, n. 296, as further amended (sick leave);
- the provisions of the Decree of the Minister of Labour and Social Welfare 12/07/2007, published in Official Gazette no. 247 of 23/10/2007 (maternity).

Apart from the cases provided for and regulated by the above provisions, is possible to suspend the research activity for a pre-determined number of months. Suspension is given by the Board of the Department; at the end of the suspension the “*assegno di ricerca*” will resume or will be permanently stopped.

In all cases of suspension, the payment is immediately interrupted until the date of resumption of the activities, certified by the Director of the Department.

In the case of anticipate conclusion of the research activity, the monthly installment will be paid proportionally.

Art.3

To participate in selection it is mandatory to have gained:

- Ph.D. in ‘**Architecture, Town Planning, Urban Planning** or equivalent.
The research doctorate obtained abroad must be declared equivalent, for selective purposes only, by the Council of the Department of Architecture.
- a Master Degree in Architecture, Urban Planning (LM-4 in Current Academic System) obtained at an Italian university, or a qualification obtained abroad obtained according to the system prior to the Ministerial Decree 509/99;
- a proven and appropriate scientific and professional curriculum demonstrating aptitude for research activities;

The candidate must possess the required qualification within the deadline indicated in paragraph 4, under penalty of exclusion.

English proficiency, both written and spoken, is a key requirement for this position. During the interview, this will be evaluated through a discussion on the main research project topics.

Art. 4

Application must include:

- **appropriate scientific and professional curriculum demonstrating aptitude for research activities;**
- **autocertification for the Degrees and Ph.D. (ANNEX B);**
- (if any) **list of other titles and or previous scientific publication (ANNEX C);**
- **Copy of a valid passport.**

Art. 5

The grants are awarded following a comparative evaluation based on the candidates' qualifications and an interview, which may take place via an online platform.

The Commission will define the criteria of the selection before proceeding with the evaluation.

The selection process consists of two different phases:

- 1) the evaluation of the candidate profile based on titles, CV and any other provided documentation;
- 2) an oral interview.

The qualification evaluation session will take place on 20 May 2024 and the interview will take place on 27 May 2024 at 10:00 am at the Department of Architecture - Via Madonna dei Monti, 40 - 00185 ROME.

The evaluation of qualifications and the interview can also be carried out electronically via the 'Microsoft Teams' platform. Candidates admitted to take the oral test will be summoned by the Department's Research Area by email sent BY EMAIL, from the PEC architecture@ateneo.uniroma3.it or from the email ricerca.architettura@uniroma3.it to the PEC addresses or e-mails indicated by the candidates. They must present themselves with a suitable and valid identification document.

Art. 6

1. The research grant cannot be awarded to students enrolled in undergraduate, Master, or medical specialization in Italy or abroad, and involves placement on unpaid leave for employee in service with public administrations other than those referred to in point 3 below.

2. Participation in selection is not allowed for spouses, relatives and kin up to and including the 4th degree of the:

- teaching staff of the Department which has issued this notice;
- Rector;
- General Director;
- Members of the Board of Directors.

3. Permanent employees of Universities, research and experimentation institutes or public bodies, the National Institute for New Technologies, Energy and Sustainable Economic Development (ENEA), the Italian Space Agency (ASI) and institutions whose scientific specialization qualifications have been recognized as equivalent to a Ph.D. pursuant to article 74, fourth paragraph, of Presidential Decree no. 382 of 11 July 1980, cannot participate in selection.

4. The research grant cannot be combined with any scholarships, except those awarded by national or foreign institutes to supplement research activities of said temporary research fellows with permanence abroad.

5. The grant for carrying out research activities is governed by a specific individual contract, based on the following criteria: flexibility in meeting the needs of the activity, continuity, time allocation (not sporadic),

coordination with the overall activities of the Department, close relationship with the implementation of a research program, autonomous activity within the scope of the program and absence of pre-determined working hours.
