

Dear Partners,

The University of Roma Tre, safeguarding the health, well-being and safety of students and staff, and following the regulations issued by the Italian Government, has taken the decision to suspend all face-to-face activities from 6 March 2020 and until further notice.

We have provided all students – including incoming affiliate students on international mobility programmes - with regular information and updates on security, education and mobility issues, and will continue to provide every possible form of support. All our campuses are now closed and there will be no on-site lectures, workshops or seminars until the end of the emergency. Educational activity continues remotely and students can access their courses via designated online platforms (e.g. Teams, Moodle). Additional resources and training opportunities will be provided through these platforms. All students have been receiving regular updates about this, and instructions on how to access online courses in order to complete the current academic year. They are actively encouraged to make the most of this opportunity.

Exams are scheduled to take place in June and July. Roma Tre will arrange online exams for all students and in particular for international affiliate students. Only very few written exams in particular circumstances should be held in presence. Students are invited to verify the procedure for the exams they are enrolled in. We would be grateful if you could kindly treat our students with the same consideration. Our offices will provide detailed information to students, in due course.

In this regard, we wish to inform you that the National Erasmus Agency has informed us that it is possible to validate ECTS credits, even if they are acquired by taking remote tests. The University of Rome Tre has already informed its outgoing students that it intends to validate all credits that have been obtained in this way or any other way.

The University of Roma Tre has Erasmus partnerships with approximately 500 universities in Europe, for student and staff exchanges. We will be happy to welcome you and your students in 2020/2021, according to the usual procedures. In light of the current situation, we will be flexible regarding deadlines for nominations. We courteously ask you to adopt the same measures.

We are now planning the courses for the incoming semester. Our purpose is to schedule a part of the courses on site, with a focus on the basic ones. However, all classes (included those held in presence) will be available remotely. A complete list of the courses and their distribution will be available shortly on our website.

Our international mobility offices continue their work and are available to partners and students, for any additional information that you may find useful.
